- A. Why We Need Mind Renewal

 - a. Eph. 1:11 In Him also we have obtained an inheritance
 - 2. Protection
 - a. 1 Pet. 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.
- B. Why Christians Fail to Persevere: Do Not Understand Salvation
 - 1. Lack of Knowledge
 - a. Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge.
 - 2. Process of Salvation
 - a. Confession and belief
 - 1) Rom. 10:9 if you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.
 - 2) Rom. 10:10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.
 - b. Reception of Holy Spirit Deposit
 - 1) Eph. 1:13 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you

were **marked in him with a seal**, <u>the promised Holy Spirit</u>, ¹⁴ who is <u>a</u> <u>deposit</u> *guaranteeing our inheritance* until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory.

 - a. If you do not understand salvation, you do not understand your inheritance
 - b. If you do not understand your inheritance, you will not understand the process of regeneration
- C. Regeneration
 - 1. Putting in Word to Solidify Your Relationship with God
 - a. Phil. 2:12-13 Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed—not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence—*continue to work out your salvation* with fear and trembling, ¹³ for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose.
 - 1) Respect for not disobeying God
 - 2) Respect for not putting conflict between you and the Lord
 - 3) Respect for knowing to have a sensitive conscious and reject temptation
 - 2. Reading the Word Cleanses
 - a. Eph. 4:23 to be made new in the attitude of your minds
 - b. Rom. 12:2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. *Then* you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.
 - c. Col. 3:2 Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.
 - d. Tit. 3:5 He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit,
 - 3. Knowing Where the Battle Remains
 - a. 1 Pet. 1:13 Therefore, with minds that are alert and fully sober, set your hope on the grace to be brought to you when Jesus Christ is revealed at his coming.
 - b. Luke 12:5 Be dressed ready for service and keep your lamps burning
 - c. Psalm 18:39 You armed me with strength for battle; you humbled my adversaries before me.
