III. Galatians 5:1, 16, 18 – Freedom in Christ (Spirit)

- A. Galatians 5:1 For freedom Christ has set us free. Stand firm, therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.
 - 1. Stand firm (take hold of your freedom and do not look back)
- B. Galatians 5:16 Live by the Spirit1. Bondage = no Spirit
- C. Galatians 5: 18 But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not subject to the law.
 - 1. Spirit breaks rigidity
 - 2. Spirit life is unpredictable
 - 3. Spirit life is fruitful
 - 4. Spirit life is total reliance on God
 - 5. Spirit life is a life of faith
 - 6. Spirit life breaks all arguments or imposed restrictions due to fear or anxiety

- A. Ephesians 4:17 Now this I affirm and insist on in the Lord: you must no longer live as the Gentiles live, in the futility of their minds.
 - 1. No imitation of lifestyle and behaviors of unhealthy people
 - 2. No participation with unhealthy people
- B. 2 Corinthians 6:14 Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness?
 - 1. Literal break ties with unhealthy people (excuse, must witness to the lost)
 - 2. Example of firefighters
